**Entries must be post marked Monday May 23. All others will be considered late.**

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place. Champion Awards sponsored by Noble Acres Farm will be given per level over all age divisions. The highest average score of three tests within a level will be used to determine the Champion. Championship levels include Training, First and Second. One of the scores must be from the highest test of the level. Introductory tests and groups are not included.

**Directions:** From the middle of Stillwater at the intersection of Highway 177 (Perkins Road) and Highway 51, go south on 177 to 56<sup>th</sup> street. (Landmark is Masons RV on west side of road.) Turn east on 56<sup>th</sup> and proceed to York Road (1.9 miles). Go north (left) on York Road to Valley View Equestrian Center. Do not drive past the show ring when a horse is in the dressage court. This applies to arriving and leaving vehicles and trailers. Please be respectful of others.

**Rules:** USEF rules will be generally followed to biting, saddlery and use of tie-downs. Riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved hard hats and footwear with heels when mounted. Stallions must be attended at all times or stabled. All horses brought to the show must have a negative Coggins presented at the office before unloading or a copy mailed in with the entry. There is a fee of \$20 for admittance of horses not to be shown. Move in and schooling will be available Friday from 12 noon until 6pm. Children, juniors, amateurs, vintage amateurs, open and vintage open riders will ride together but be placed separately. Children are riders age 12 and under. Juniors are riders age 13 to 18. Age is determined by USDF/USEF membership rules. Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. Entries must be received by closing date at 5:00 p.m. Phone, email and late entries may be refused. If cancellations are necessary, a full refund will be made if the show manager is notified before the closing date. All fees must be paid by the closing date unless prior arrangement is made with the show manager. In such case all fees will be due when the rider checks in. After closing date, refunds will be made only with a doctor or veterinarian certificate, less \$10.00 office fee. All no-show entries will be charged to the rider. All dogs must be leashed and secured safely. Do not tie anything to trees. A round pen is available for lungeing. Wash stall is available but must be left clean. No motorized utility vehicles.

**Stabling:** Very Limited Availability. Stalls are 10'x10' with a solid door. All stalls must be cleaned on departure. Stall fee includes shavings. Any damage to the property is the responsibility of the participant. Please pick up after yourself and your animals in all of the barns and in the indoor court.

**Two New Rider Divisions: Vintage Amateurs (Riders 50+), Vintage Open (Riders 50+)**

Children (age 12 and under), juniors (age 13 to 18), Adult Amateurs (19-49), Open (19-49).
