**Western**, English or **Trail** HORSES of all ages and experience!  
**Western**, English or **Trail** TACK of all kinds!

Unmounted sessions:

- **What is "Eventing"** (answer: For the english rider it is a triathlon of dressage and jumping. For the western rider it is similar to the increasingly popular "Cowboy Challenge". For the trail rider it is similar to all things found on the trails.)
- **Grooming, braiding, tack, and attire** commonly used in eventing.
- **Principles and safe design of jumps**, both in the arena and in the field (cross country).
- **Are YOU legal?** Update on the "new" regulations for trucks and horse trailers.

Mounted lessons: Riders are welcomed, and encouraged, to take part in any or all of the mounted activities.

- **"Dressage"**: How to make your horse more responsive, how to correctly ride circles and straight lines, basic lateral movements, correct rider position, correct use of aids and cues.  
**Private 45 minute lessons. 8 lessons available.**
- **Jumping in an Arena**: from 4 inches to as high as you want to go! Emphasis on safety for both horse and rider.  
**45 minute lessons for up to 3 riders per lesson. 8 sessions.**
- **Jumping in the field** ("Cross Country"): from logs on the ground, small steps up and down banks, crossing ditches, going thru water as you encounter on trails and such, to harder obstacles if desired. Emphasis on safety for both horse and rider.  
**1 ½ hour lessons for up to 4 riders per lesson. 4 sessions.**

**Cost: \$35--includes any or all portion of the activities.**

*No charge to come watch.*

- ⇒ **Advanced registration is encouraged for mounted session to facilitate scheduling.**
- ⇒ On-site registration available: Mounted lessons will be first come, first served for available riding slots.
- ⇒ Registration is optional but recommended even if you are attending only the unmounted sessions.
  - ⇒ Membership in Oklahoma Eventers included (new members only).

Comfortable riding clothes and footwear with heels required for riding.  
Helmets required when mounted and protective vests required for jumping.  
Helmets and vests will be available for loan.
