✦ In 30 years as a dressage rider and instructor, Sherry Guess has trained horses and riders from first time under saddle to Grand Prix.

✦ She is a USDF 'L' Program dressage judge and USDF Bronze Medalist.

✦ Sherry was a participant in six USDF Instructor Seminars with Maj. Anders Lindgren, as well as riding in clinics with him for 10 years. She was also a participating instructor in Sally Swift's Instructor Program and Alumni Program for Centered Riding Instructors. She trained for seven years with Dennis Callin, then four years with Mette Rosencrantz, in addition to clinics with Beth Baumert, Lilo Fore and Steffen Peters, among others.

✦ Before moving to Oklahoma, she was active in the California Dressage Society. As an Executive Board member, she was Educa-

tional Chairman and is still a member of their APTI (Association of Professional Trainers and Instructors), participating in a variety of educational opportunities.

✦ She was instrumental in introducing Mary Wanless to the west coast and has ridden and participated in the APTI Instructor Training with Wanless for the last 15 years.

✦ In Oklahoma, she was an Executive Board member of Oklahoma Dressage Society for three years, serving as President for two. She has also been chairman of the USDF GMO Council for the last nine years and also serves on the USDF Membership Committee.
