Amendment to ODS Policies and Procedures

The Oklahoma Dressage Society Board of Directors has made an amendment to the ODS Policies and Procedures. The revision is as follows (supplementary verbiage underlined):

The Nominating Committee shall consist of Chapter Presiding Officers and at-large members selected by the ODS President. In the event that a Chapter Presiding Officer is unable to serve (i.e. would like to run for the ODS Board), the Chapter Presiding Officer may designate another Chapter Board Member to serve on the Nominating Committee in their stead. The ODS President shall appoint a Nominating Committee Chairman from this Nominating Committee.

The revision was made to clarify ambiguous language that would have prevented non-chapter members from serving, which, clearly, was not the original intent.

Preparation is the Basis of the Extended Trot

When your test calls for an extended trot on the diagonal, you must prepare your horse on the short side. Try to engage your horse a little more by riding well through the corner with the inside leg firmly on the horse and the outside rein giving support and balance. After the corner, the horse should be straightened and a half halt should precede the first extended stride.

Once the horse executes the extension, you must move your hands a little forward to permit the neck to stretch and to give more freedom of the shoulder. Keep the rhythm in your hands. Watch that your horse does not fall on the forehand or start running. Give a half halt when crossing the center line to avoid these problems.
